

Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg Offer for the season 2007

Offer for projects in 2007

The Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg invites choreographers and companies from the area of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and the Greater Region to hand in pieces for the program 2007. Applications can be submitted in English, German or French at your convenience and should contain the following information:

- Name and address of choreographer
- Name and address of company
- Classification as newcomer, advanced or established
- Name of piece
- Duration of piece in minutes
- Names of participants in the performance
- Short description of the piece of a maximum of 1.200 characters (including blanks) both in English and French
- Estimated cost of performance
- Need of accommodation in case your application is accepted (number of people and nights; accommodation (at a max. 2 nights) will be covered by the Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg)
- VHS or DVD of the entire piece proposed
- CV of choreographer
- List of tour dates (June 2006 – January 2007)

We maintain the right to disregard applications that do not meet the above requirements.

Details

Date and Place

- Date of Festival: 26 - 30 June 2007
- Deadline for applications: **15 January 2007** (by which date the application has to reach us via postal mail, address please see below);

- Decision on application: 15 February 2007
- The Festival takes place at the Grand Théâtre de la Ville de Luxembourg

Geographical region

The Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg invites 2007 companies and choreographers from Luxembourg and the Greater Region, encompassing the areas of:

- Grand Duchy of Luxembourg
- Saarland

- Rheinland-Pfalz
- Lorraine
- Wallonie

Pieces

The Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg does not produce pieces, but invite guest performances. The pieces proposed have to be productions in the area of contemporary dance and have to be presented on stage no later than December 2006. They must not be presented within the territory of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg from April 2007 until July 2007 (included).

Classification

The Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg combines pieces from choreographers with different experience and public name recognition. In order to facilitate the combination for us, we would like to ask you to classify yourself along the following lines:

- Newcomer: I am just starting choreography as a career and would like to present one of my first pieces.
- Advanced: I have several years of experience in the choreographic profession and am known as a choreographer in my area.
- Established: I have a long experience in the choreographic field and have several time been able to organize performances outside of my region.

In case of questions, please get back to us. The classification is just a first step and is designed to help us. The final evaluation, however, will be taken by the Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg's artistic direction.

Duration

The proposed pieces should not exceed the following durations:

- Newcomer: 10 min
- Advanced: 25 min
- Established: 50 min

Technical Set-up

The Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg will design a basic light plan in accordance with the Grand Théâtre de la Ville de Luxembourg. Additionally, there will be 10 light extras at each company's proposal which can be freely placed (within the realms of possibility of the theatre)

We will do our best to make sure that each company and each piece have good conditions for rehearsals and performance, but we would like to ask for understanding in case that the specific requirements will surpass our possibilities in a given situation.

Selection

The Danz Festival Lëtzebuerg will make a selection from the proposed pieces. The decision is not subject to jurisdiction in as much as the artistic evaluation process is concerned.
